#### 6. PURPOSE:

- A. The believer is to <u>walk</u> in the <u>commandment</u> of <u>love</u> and <u>abide</u> in true doctrine.
- B. The believer is not even to be hospitable to deceivers and transgressors of the doctrine of Christ who are anti-christs.

#### 9. SUMMARY:

This second epistle of John is either a personal epistle written to a Christian lady and her children or a church epistle written to a local church and its members. In either circumstance the truth of this epistle is intended for all believers. In the first section of the epistle John emphasizes walking in true doctrine, keeping the commandment of love. The second section gives warning concerning those who transgress true doctrine, showing that they are deceivers and anti-christs. He exhorts them not even to show hospitality to those false brethren. The basic principles in this epistle arise from the teachings of Christ found in John's Gospel.

#### 10. CHRIST SEEN:

Christ is seen as the <u>Truth</u>, the <u>Son</u>, and the <u>Christ</u> who is come in the flesh.
