#### Matthew 4:1-5

<sup>1</sup> Then Jesus was led up by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.

<sup>2</sup> And when He had fasted forty days and forty nights, afterward He was hungry.

<sup>3</sup> Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread."



<sup>4</sup> But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God.'"

## Philippians 2:5-11

- <sup>5</sup> Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus,
- 6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God,
- <sup>7</sup> but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.
- <sup>8</sup> And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.
- <sup>9</sup> Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name,



<sup>10</sup> that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth,

<sup>11</sup> and *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.



## **Daniel 4:28-30**

- <sup>28</sup> All this came upon King Nebuchadnezzar.
- <sup>29</sup> At the end of the twelve months he was walking about the royal palace of Babylon.
- <sup>30</sup> The king spoke, saying, "Is not this great Babylon, that I have built for a royal dwelling by my mighty power and for the honor of my majesty?"



## Deuteronomy 8:17-18

<sup>17</sup> then you say **in your heart**, 'My power and the might of my hand have gained me this wealth.'

<sup>18</sup> "And you shall remember the LORD your God, for *it* is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish His covenant which He swore to your fathers, as *it* is this day.
