



Purge Out The Old Leaven Consecrate Yourself

Ludwig

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2 Chronicles 5:11-14

¹¹ And it came to pass when the priests came out of the *Most Holy Place* (for **all the priests** who were present had **sanctified themselves**, without keeping to their divisions),

¹² and the Levites *who were* the singers, all those of Asaph and Heman and Jeduthun, with their sons and their brethren, stood at the east end of the altar, clothed in white linen, having cymbals, stringed instruments and harps, and with them one hundred and twenty priests sounding with trumpets—



¹³ indeed it came to pass, when the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD, and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and praised the LORD, saying:

*“For He is good,
For His mercy endures forever,”*

that the house, the house of the LORD, was filled with a cloud,

¹⁴ so that the priests could not continue ministering because of the cloud; for the glory of the LORD filled the house of God.



Exodus 19:10-11

¹⁰ Then the LORD said to Moses, “**Go to the people and consecrate (Sanctify) them today and tomorrow, and let them wash their clothes.**

¹¹ And let them be **ready** for the third day. For on the third day the **LORD will come** down upon Mount Sinai in the sight of all the people.

¹⁶ Then it came to pass on the third day,...

¹⁷ And Moses brought the people out of the camp to **meet** with God,



Joshua 3:5

⁵ And Joshua said to the people, “**Sanctify yourselves**, for tomorrow the LORD will do wonders among you.”



Consecrate (Sanctify) Yourself

From the **Hebrew word “Kadash”** which is the **root word for “HOLY.”**

- **To be clean (To Sanctify)**
- **To purify**
- **To be separated**
- **To be set apart**
- **To dedicate**

We make ourselves ready to meet God (Ex 19:11, 17)

1 Corinthians 5:6-8

⁶ Your glorying *is* not good. Do you not know that a **little leaven leavens the whole lump?**

⁷ Therefore **purge out the old leaven**, that you may be a **new lump**, since you truly are **unleavened**. For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us.

⁸ Therefore let us keep the feast, not with **old leaven**, nor with the **leaven of malice** and **wickedness**, but with the **unleavened bread** of **sincerity** and **truth**.



Leaven Naturally

Leaven (or yeast) when placed in a batch of dough has the action of fermentation. Leaven puffs up. It works **silently**, **secretly** and **gradually**, until then whole is leavened.



Matthew 16:6-12

⁶ Then Jesus said to them, “Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and the Sadducees.”

...

¹² Then they understood that He did not tell *them* to beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and Sadducees.



Mark 8:15

¹⁵ Then He charged them, saying, “Take heed, beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and the leaven of Herod.”



5 Types of Leaven

1. Leaven of the Pharisees
2. Leaven of Galatia
3. Leaven of Sadducees
4. Leaven of Herod
5. Leaven of Corinth



1. Leaven of the Pharisees - Hypocrisy

- Say something you have no intention to keep
- A form of godliness
- Externalism – Tick the boxes
- Two Face

Sincerity and Truthfulness



2. Leaven of Galatia – Legalism

- Galatians 5 (Issue on Circumscision)
- Self-righteousness
- Likes the old and looks to the old
- Unable to see the new in the old concealed
- Satisfied and bound with Tradition and Religion
- Stiff & Rigid to the moves of God

Word & Spirit must be together



Galatians 3:3

³ Are you so foolish? Having begun in the Spirit, are you now being made perfect by the flesh?



Galatians 5:16-18

¹⁶ I say then: Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

¹⁷ For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.

¹⁸ But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law.



3. Leaven of Sadducees - Modernism

- Interested in Position, Power & Prosperity
- Want to be seen and recognised
- Becoming Relevant at the expense of compromise
- Didn't believe in the resurrection
- Leads to doctrine of demons
- Beware of political propaganda
- Stay true to the Bible



4. Leaven of Herod - Worldliness

- Herod wanted a place of Power under Rome
- Turn to the world's offer
- No standard of God's Word
- Fear of men vs Fear of God
- World and the Church

Seek first the Kingdom of God and His Righteousness



5. Leaven of Corinth - Carnality

- Life of the flesh
- Life of sin
- Envy, strife, divisions, malice and wickedness
- The un-renewed mind

Renew our minds with the Word of God
