- 1. The **Unveiling** of the **Glory of the LORD** (2 Corinthians 3:14-18)

 Turn and look up to Jesus
- 2. The **Revealing** of the **Sons of God** (Romans 8) Be led and Walk in the Spirit not the flesh
- 3. The **Renewing** of the **Inward-Man** (2 Corinthians 4:16)
 - It is not according to flesh but the Spirit

1 Corinthians 4:5

⁵ Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord comes, who will both bring to light the hidden things of darkness and reveal the counsels of the hearts. Then each one's praise will come from God.

What is God Unveiling?

His Glory: It has to do with God's nature, character
 & Attributes.

- A. His Image & Likeness (2 Corinthians 3:16-18)
- B. His Goodness (Exodus 33:18-33)
- C. His Oneness (John 17)



2 Corinthians 4:6

⁶ For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the **glory of God** in the **face of Jesus Christ**.



- The Light is revealing the weakness of the flesh
- We cannot change from Glory to Glory unless we behold Him
- What are we beholding? What do we see?
- Abraham vs Lot
- Is what we are seeing with our eyes affecting our spiritual eyes?



Matthew 6:22-23

²² "The lamp of the body is the eye. If therefore your eye is good, your whole body will be full of light.

²³ But if your eye is bad, your whole body will be full of darkness. If therefore the light that is in you is darkness, how great is that darkness!



Proverbs 20:27

²⁷ The spirit of a man is the lamp of the Lord, Searching all the inner depths of his heart.



Luke 24:27

²⁷ And **beginning at Moses** and all the **Prophets**, He expounded to them in **all the Scriptures** the things concerning **Himself**.



Luke 24:31-32

³¹ Then their **eyes** were **opened** and they knew Him; and He vanished from their sight.

⁴⁵ And He **opened** their **understanding**, that they might comprehend the Scriptures.



1. Spiritual Things must be understood with the Spirit

- That which is born of the flesh is flesh and that which is born of the Spirit, is spirit
- The Words I speak to you they are Spirit and they are Life
- Luke 24:15-16 They reasoned
- 1 Cor 2:13-14 Spiritual Man Vs Natural Man
- What are we searching in the scriptures?
- Use/From the heart Where is the heart?
- No Root, cares of this world, deceitfulness of riches and desires for other things?



Luke 24:15-16

¹⁵ So it was, while they conversed and reasoned, that Jesus Himself drew near and went with them.

¹⁶ But their eyes were restrained, so that they did not know Him.





1 Corinthians 2:13-14

¹³ These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

¹⁴ But the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.





2. Visible Reveals The Invisible

- Creation reveals the Creator
- Natural points to the Spiritual
- Earthly things points to the Heavenly things
- Parables uses the earthly language to reveal the spiritual message
- Work on the earthly things that pertains to our lives.



Romans 1:20

²⁰ For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse,



1 Corinthians 15:46

46 However, the spiritual is not first, but the natural, and afterward the spiritual.



John 3:12

12 If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe, how will you believe if I tell you heavenly things?



3. God Reveals Progressively

- God has to deal with us before He reveals more
- Embrace the process
- One lesson I have been learning is to lay it on the altar.
- See Abraham Genesis 15-17 (13 years)
