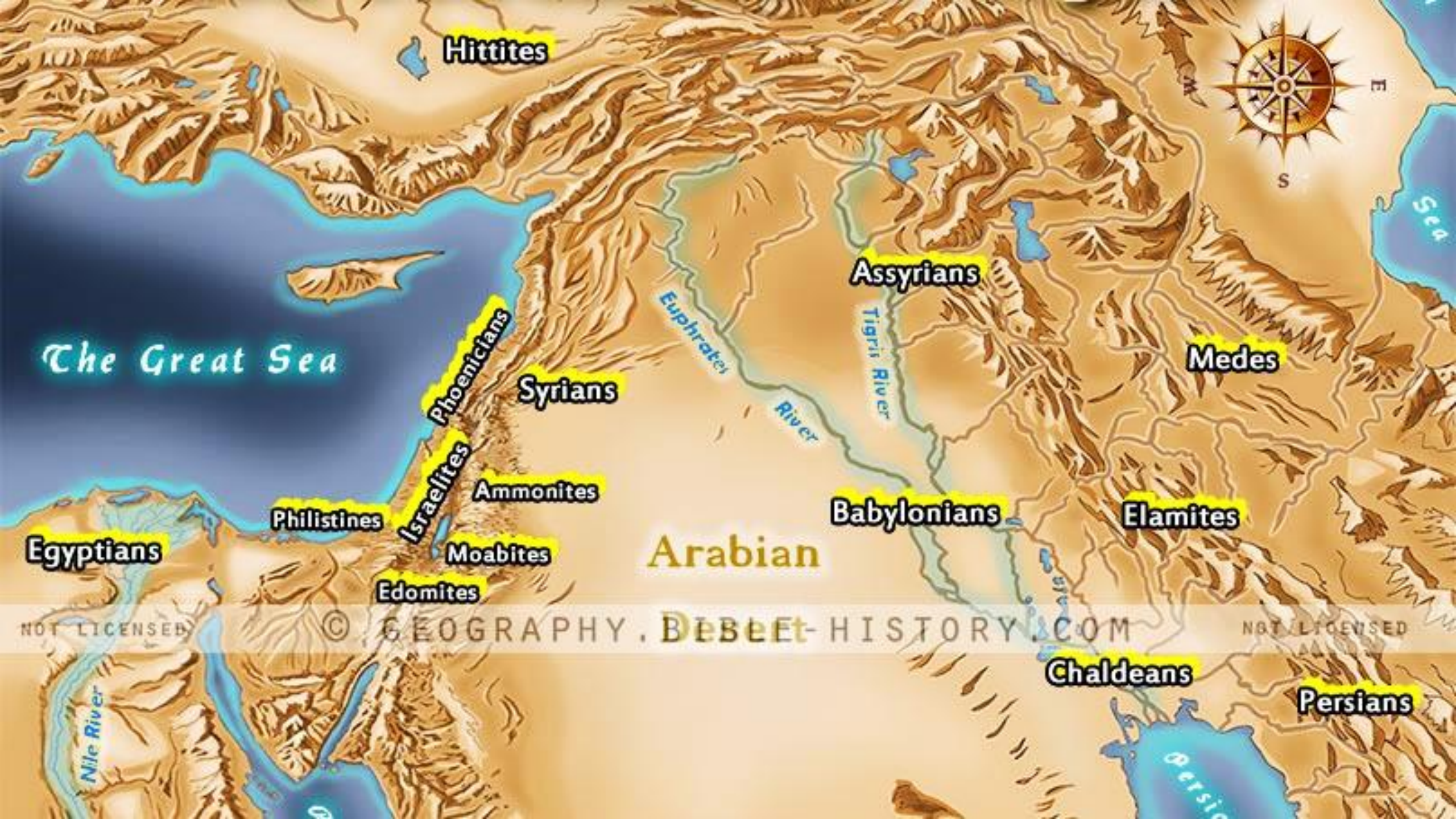

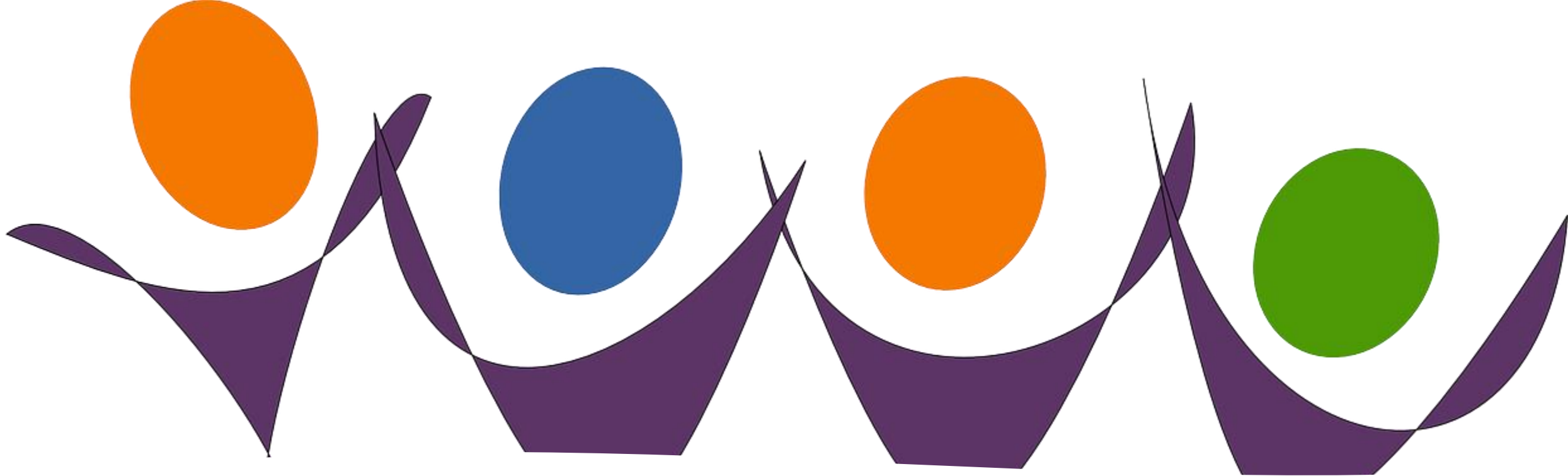

# Jonah 1:1-2

<sup>1</sup> Now the word of the Lord came to Jonah the son of Amittai, saying,

<sup>2</sup> “**Arise, go to Nineveh**, that great city, and cry out against it; for **their wickedness** has come up before Me.”



# Jonah 4:11

<sup>11</sup> And should I not pity **Nineveh**, that great city, in which are more than one hundred and twenty thousand persons who **cannot discern** between their **right hand** and their **left**—and much livestock?”



# Isaiah 52:10

<sup>10</sup> The LORD has made bare  
His holy arm  
In the **eyes of all the  
nations;**  
And all the ends of the earth  
shall see  
The **salvation** of our God.



# Isaiah 66:18

18 “For I know their works and their thoughts. It shall be that I will gather **all nations and tongues;** and **they shall come and see My glory.**



# Isaiah 2:2

<sup>2</sup> Now it shall come to pass in the latter days  
*That* the mountain of the LORD's house  
Shall be established on the top of the mountains,  
And shall be exalted above the hills;  
And **all nations shall flow to it.**



# 3. God's Vision For His Church

# To Abraham

<sup>3</sup> I will bless those who  
bless you,  
And I will curse him who  
curses you;  
And in you **all the  
families of the earth  
shall be blessed.**”

**Genesis 12:3**



# Galatians 3:6-9

<sup>6</sup> just as Abraham “believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness.” <sup>7</sup> Therefore know that *only* those who are of faith are sons of Abraham.

<sup>8</sup> And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the **Gentiles** by faith, preached the **gospel** to **Abraham** beforehand, *saying*, “In you **all the nations** shall be **blessed**.”

<sup>9</sup> So then those who *are* of **faith** are **blessed** with believing Abraham.





# The Revelation of The Vision of Christ

## Isaiah 6:1-8

<sup>1</sup> In the year that King Uzziah died, **I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His *robe* filled the temple.**

<sup>2</sup> Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew.

<sup>3</sup> And one cried to another and said:  
**“Holy, holy, holy *is* the LORD of hosts; The whole earth *is* full of His glory!”**



<sup>4</sup> And the posts of the door were shaken by the voice of him who cried out, and the house was filled with smoke.

<sup>5</sup> So I said:

“Woe *is* me, for I am undone!  
Because I *am* a man of unclean lips,  
And I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips;  
For my eyes have seen the King,  
The LORD of hosts.”

<sup>6</sup> Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a live coal *which* he had taken with the tongs from the altar.



7 And he touched my mouth *with it*, and said:

“Behold, this has touched your lips;  
Your iniquity is taken away,  
And your sin purged.”

8 Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying:

**“Whom shall I send,  
And who will go for Us?”**

Then I said, **“Here *am* I! Send me.”**
