- ² in the first year of his reign I, Daniel, <u>understood</u> by the books the number of the years *specified* by the <u>word of the LORD through Jeremiah</u> the prophet, that He would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem.
 - ³**THEN I set my face** toward the Lord God to make request by **prayer** and **supplications**, with **fasting**, **sackcloth**, and **ashes**.

1) It is an Attitude
