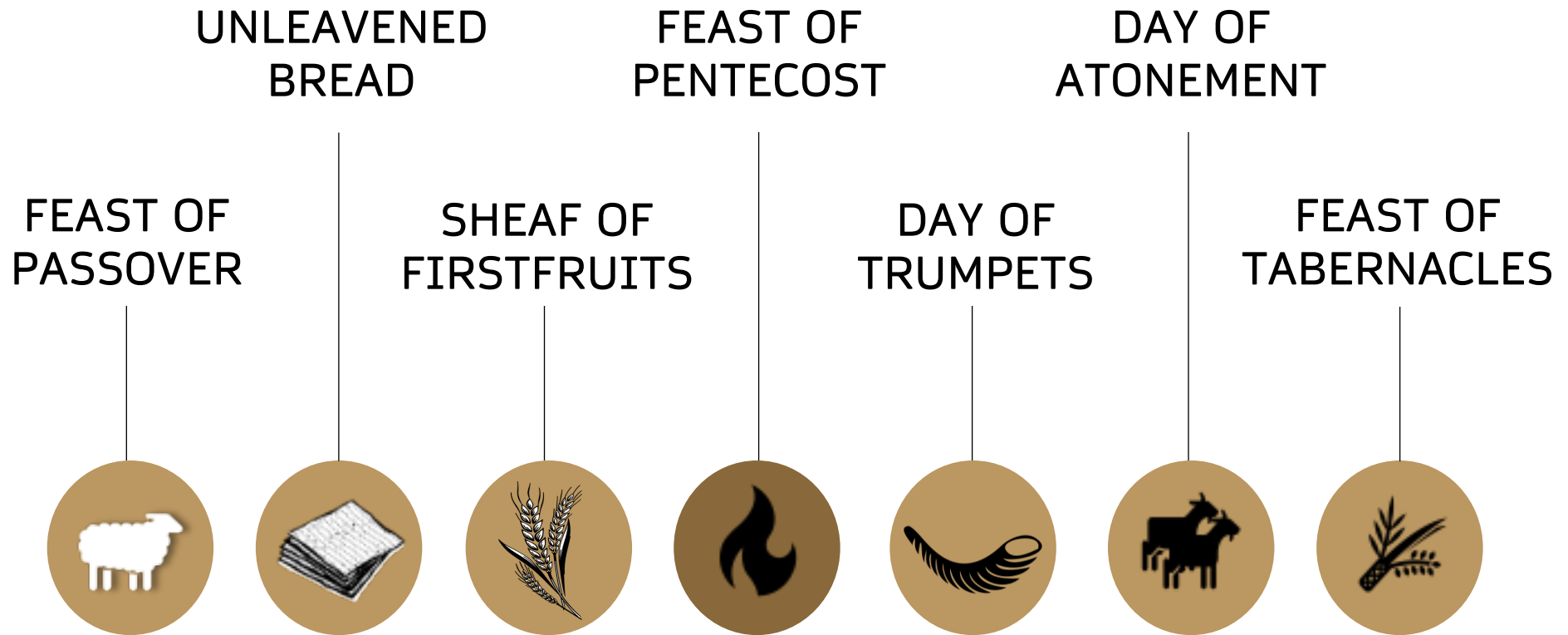

Tabernacles

- Hebrew: **Sukkot** means **hut**.
- First and the eight days were a **day of rest**
- Custom took place when all the **summer harvest** was gathered in at the end of the year.
- **Made booths** which are temporary shelters of goodly trees, palm and willow, the olive, pine and myrtle, etc... for **seven days**
- **Rejoice** before the LORD **seven days**.
- Brought burnt, grain and sin **offerings**



FEASTS OF THE LORD



Leviticus 23:1-2

¹ And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,

² “Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them:
‘The feasts of the LORD, which you shall
proclaim *to be* holy convocations,
these are My feasts.’

Hebrew: MOED



Leviticus 23:4

4 'These *are* the feasts of the LORD, holy convocations which you shall proclaim at their appointed times.

Genesis 1:14-19

¹⁴ Then God said, “Let there be lights in the firmament of the heavens to divide the day from the night; and let them be for **signs** and **seasons**, and for **days** and **years**;

¹⁵ and let them be for lights in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth”; and it was so.



¹⁶ Then God made two great lights: the greater **light to rule the day**, and the **lesser light to rule the night**. *He made the stars also.*

¹⁷ God set them in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth,

¹⁸ and to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the light from the darkness. And God saw that *it was good.*

¹⁹ So the evening and the morning were the **fourth day**.

From H3259; properly an appointment, that is, a fixed time or season; specifically a festival; conventionally a year; by implication, an assembly (as convened for a definite purpose); technically the congregation; by extension, the place of meeting; also a signal (as appointed beforehand)



Deuteronomy 16:16

¹⁶ “Three times a year all your males shall **appear before the LORD your God** in the place which He chooses: at the **Feast of Unleavened Bread**, at the **Feast of Weeks**, and at the **Feast of Tabernacles**; and they shall not appear before the LORD empty-handed.



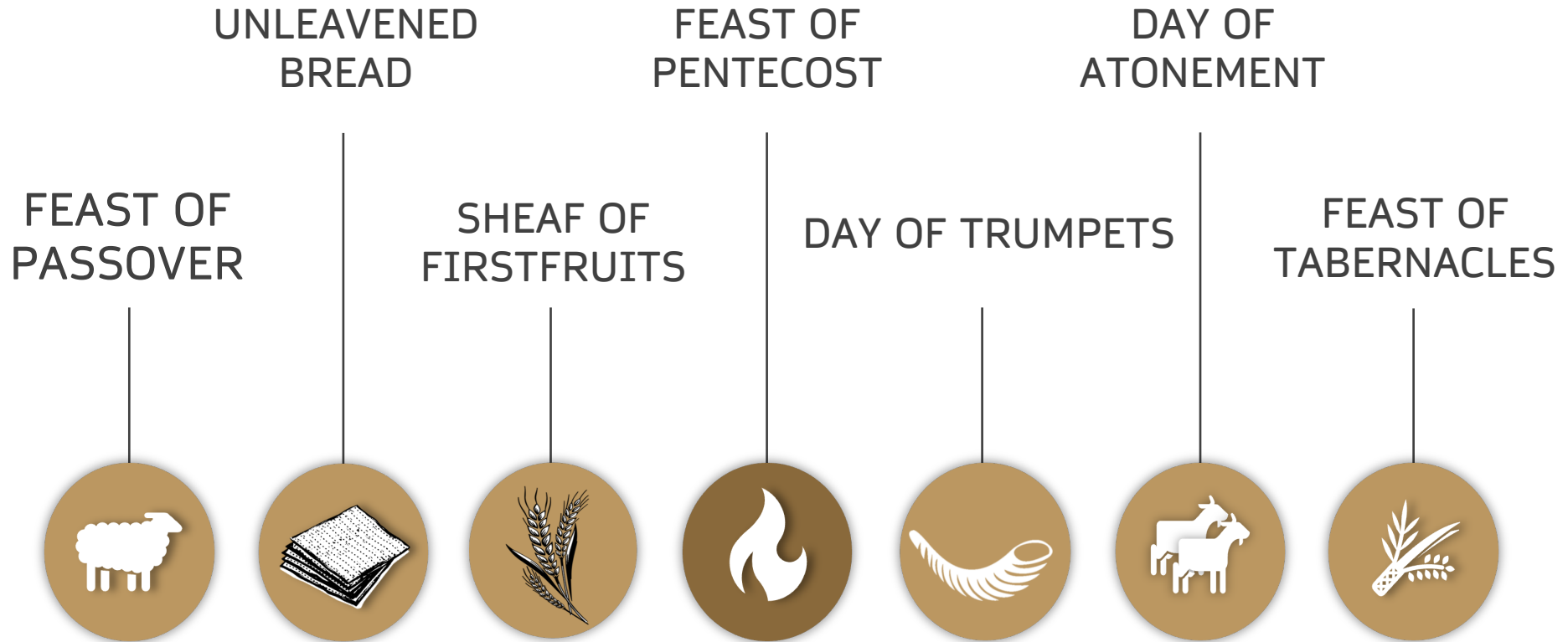
Colossians 2:16-17

¹⁶ So let no one judge you in food or in drink, or regarding a **festival** or a **new moon** or **sabbaths**,

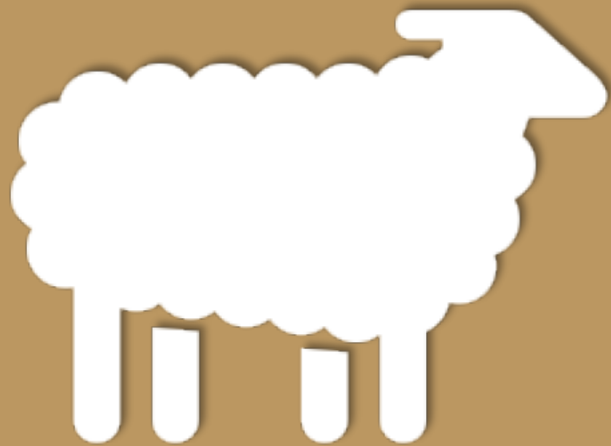
¹⁷ which are a **shadow** of things to come, but the **substance is of Christ.**

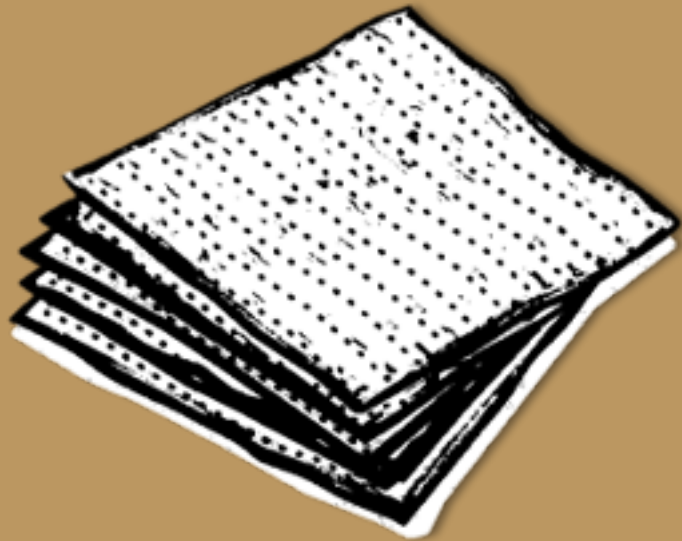

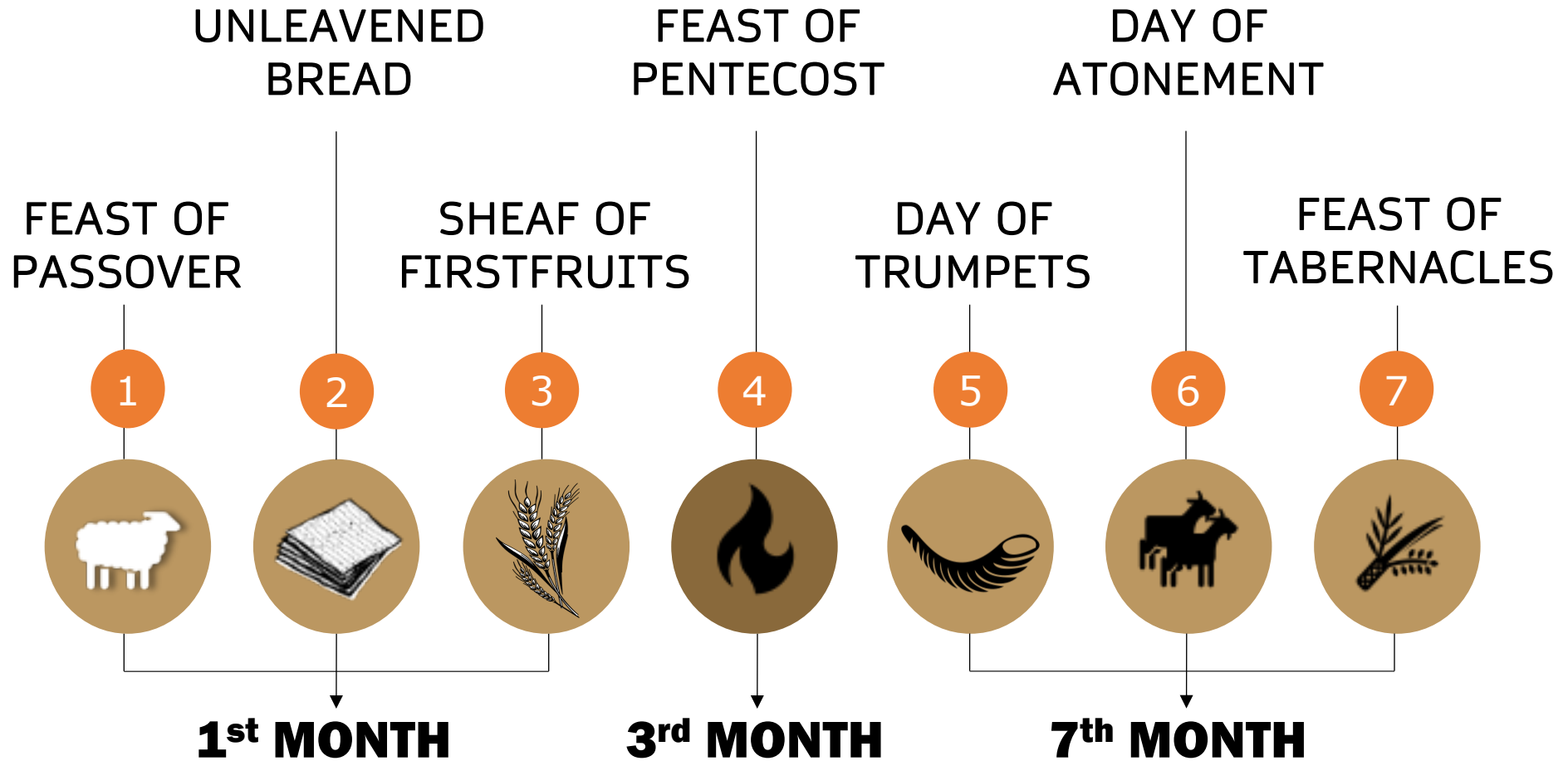
The number **seven** is the number of

FEASTS OF THE LORD



1. Looking For The Heavenly Eternal City

- **I brought them out of the land of Egypt :**
- They were but **pilgrims** looking for the promise land.
- **I made the children of Israel dwell in booths:** Lived in **temporary** dwelling places until they entered the promise land, a place of **permanency**.
- Physical body Temporary dwelling place
- Looking for the **Heavenly** and **Eternal Jerusalem**



1. Looking For The Heavenly Eternal City

Leviticus
23:42-43

I brought them out of the land of Egypt :

*They were but **pilgrims** looking for the promise land.*

I made the children of Israel dwell in booths:

*From **temporary** dwelling places to a place of **permanency**.*



Leviticus 23:42-43

⁴² You shall dwell in booths for seven days. All who are native Israelites shall dwell in booths,

⁴³ that your generations may know that I made the children of Israel dwell in booths when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I *am* the LORD your God.' ”



1 Peter 2:11

¹¹ Beloved, I beg *you* as **sojourners** and **pilgrims**, abstain from fleshly lusts which war against the soul,

¹² having your conduct honorable among the Gentiles, that when they speak against you as evildoers, they may, by *your* good works which they observe, glorify God in the day of visitation.



Hebrews 11:9-10

⁹ By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as *in* a foreign country, dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise;

¹⁰ for he **waited** for the city which has foundations, whose builder and maker *is* God.



2 Peter 3:13

¹³ Nevertheless we, according to His promise, **look** for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.



2. Be Watchful

Knowing that the **Feast** points to the end of the age, and the second coming of Christ:

Opposite of watchfulness:

- a) Carelessness
- b) Sleeping
- c) Indifferent
- d) Misinformed



Watchfulness

- **Readiness, diligence** (Revelation 3:1-3)
- **Prayerfulness** (Matthew 26:36-45)
- Alert to what the LORD is **saying** (3fold) (Hab 2:1-3)
- Breastplate of **faith** and **love** (1 Thess 5:1-6)
- Helmet, the **hope** of **Salvation** (1 Thess 5:1-6)
- Walking in the **Light** of God's Truth (1 Thess 5:1-6)



Revelation 3:1-3

¹ “And to the angel of the church in Sardis write, ‘These things says He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars: “I know your works, that you have a name that you are alive, but you are dead.

² **Be watchful**, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die, for I have not found your works perfect before God.



³ Remember therefore how you have received and heard; hold fast and repent. Therefore **if you will not watch, I will come upon you as a thief, and you will not know what hour I will come upon you.**



Matthew 26:36-45

³⁶ Then Jesus came with them to a place called Gethsemane, and said to the disciples, “Sit here while I go and pray over there.”

³⁷ And He took with Him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and He began to be sorrowful and deeply distressed.



38 Then He said to them, “My soul is exceedingly sorrowful, even to death. **Stay** here and **watch** with Me.”

39 He went a little farther and fell on His face, and prayed, saying, “O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as You *will*.”



40 Then He came to the disciples and found them sleeping, and said to Peter, “**What! Could you not watch with Me one hour?**

41 **Watch and pray**, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed *is* willing, but the flesh *is* weak.”



42 Again, a second time, He went away and prayed, saying, “O My Father, if this cup cannot pass away from Me unless I drink it, Your will be done.”

43 And He came and found them asleep again, for their eyes were heavy.

44 So He left them, went away again, and prayed the third time, saying the same words.



45 Then He came to His disciples and said to them, “Are *you* still sleeping and resting? **Behold, the hour is at hand**, and the Son of Man is being betrayed into the hands of sinners.



Habakkuk 2:1-3

¹ I will **stand** my **watch**
And **set myself** on the rampart,
And watch **to see** what He will say to me,
And what I will answer when I am corrected.

² Then the LORD answered me and said:
“Write the **vision**
And make *it* plain on tablets,
That he may run who reads it.



³ For the **vision** *is* yet for **an appointed time**;
But at the end **it** will speak, and **it** will not lie.
 Though it tarries, wait for **it**;
 Because **it** will surely come,
 It will not tarry.



1 Thessalonians 5:1-6

¹ But concerning the times and the seasons, brethren, you have no need that I should write to you.

² For you yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so comes as a thief in the night.

³ For when they say, “Peace and safety!” then sudden destruction comes upon them, as labor pains upon a pregnant woman. And they shall not escape.



⁴ But you, brethren, are not in darkness, so that this Day should overtake you as a thief.

⁵ You are all sons of light and sons of the day. We are not of the night nor of darkness.

⁶ Therefore let us not sleep, as others *do*, but let us watch and be sober.



⁷ For those who sleep, sleep at night, and those who get drunk are drunk at night.

⁸ But let us who are of the day be sober, **putting on the breastplate of faith and love**, and *as a helmet the hope of salvation*.
