

REDEEMER



A primitive root, to *redeem* (according to the Oriental law of kinship), that is, to *be the next of kin* (and as such to *buy back* a relative's property, *marry* his widow, etc.): - X in any wise, X at all, avenger, deliver, (do, perform the part of near, next) kinsfolk (-man), purchase, ransom, redeem (-er), revenger.

THE LAW




- · A brother becomes poor

THE LAW




- A <u>brother</u> becomes <u>poor</u>

BOAZ

Ruth 3:9

⁹ And he said, "Who are you?"

So she answered, "I am Ruth, your maidservant. Take your maidservant under your wing, for you are a **close relative**."

Ruth 3:12

¹² Now it is true that I am a close **relative**; however, there is a **relative** closer than I.

Ruth 3:13

¹³ Stay this night, and in the morning it shall be that if he will perform the duty of a **close relative** for you—good; let him do it. But if he does not want to perform the duty for you, then I will perform the duty for you, as the LORD lives! Lie down until morning."

Ruth 4:1-10

¹ Now Boaz went up to the gate and sat down there; and behold, the close relative of whom Boaz had spoken came by. So Boaz said, "Come aside, friend, sit down here." So he came aside and sat down.

² And he took ten men of the elders of the city, and said, "Sit down here." So they sat down.

³ Then he said to the **close relative**, "Naomi, who has come back from the country of Moab, sold the piece of land which belonged to our brother Elimelech.

⁴ And I thought to inform you, saying, 'Buy it back in the presence of the inhabitants and the elders of my people. If you will redeem it, redeem it; but if you will not redeem it, then tell me, that I may know; for there is no one but you to redeem it, and I am next after you.'"

And he said, "I will redeem it."

⁵ Then Boaz said, "On the day you buy the field from the hand of Naomi, you must also buy it from Ruth the Moabitess, the wife of the dead, to perpetuate the name of the dead through his inheritance."

And the close relative said, "I cannot redeem it for myself, lest I ruin my own inheritance. You redeem my right of redemption for yourself, for I cannot redeem it."

⁷ Now this was the custom in former times in Israel concerning redeeming and exchanging, to confirm anything: one man took off his sandal and gave it to the other, and this was a confirmation in Israel.

⁸ Therefore the close relative said to Boaz, "Buy it for yourself." So he took off his sandal.

⁹ And Boaz said to the elders and all the people, "You are witnesses this day that I have bought all that was Elimelech's, and all that was Chilion's and Mahlon's, from the hand of Naomi.

Moreover, Ruth the Moabitess, the widow of Mahlon, I have acquired as my wife, to perpetuate the name of the dead through his inheritance, that the name of the dead may not be cut off from among his brethren and from his position at the gate. You are witnesses this day."

JESUS CHRIST




1. Jesus our Kinsman Redeemer by incarnation & virgin birth

3. Jesus paid the full redemptive price with His Blood




Genesis 1:26-27

¹² teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age,


¹³ looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,

Revelation 4:9-11

⁹ Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever,

10 the twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying:

11 "You are worthy, O Lord,
To receive glory and honor and power;
For You **created all things**,
And by **Your will** they **exist** and were **created**."
