
To cause to be conformed or adjusted to a specified norm or standard






¹ Give ear, O Shepherd of Israel, You who lead Joseph like a flock; You who **dwell** between the cherubim, shine forth!

Etymology


ATONE

To bring at one, to reconcile, and thence to suffer the pains of whatever sacrifice is necessary to bring about a reconciliation.



















Mercy Seat
