1. JESUS IS THE KING PRIEST AFTER THE ORDER OF MELCHIZEDEK




Hebrews 1:1-3

- ¹ God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets,
- ² has in these last days spoken to us by *His Son*, whom He has appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the worlds;

³ who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power, when He had by <u>Himself purged our sins</u>, <u>sat down at the right</u> <u>hand of the Majesty on high</u>,

KING OF RIGHTEOUSNESS






Hebrews 10:12-13

¹² But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, **sat down** at the **right hand of God**,

¹³ from that time waiting till **His enemies are made His footstool**.

Romans 6:23 ²³ For the **wages** of **sin** is **death**,





but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Genesis 4:6-7

⁶So the LORD said to Cain, ...

⁷ If you do well, will you not be accepted? And if you do not do well, sin lies at the door. And its desire is for you, but you should rule over it."



1 Corinthians 15:26

²⁶ The **last enemy** that will be destroyed is **death**.



Romans 5:9-11

- ⁹Much more then, having now been **justified** by His **blood**, we shall be **saved** from **wrath** through Him.
- ¹⁰ For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.

¹¹ And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation. ¹² Therefore, just as through one man sin entered the world, and death through sin, and thus death spread to all men, because all sinned—

¹³ (For until the law sin was in the world, but sin is not imputed when there is no law.

¹⁴ Nevertheless **death reigned** from Adam to Moses, even over those who had not sinned according to the likeness of the transgression of Adam, who is a type of Him who was to come. ¹⁵ But the free gift is not like the offense. For if by the one man's offense many died, much more the grace of God and the gift by the grace of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abounded to many.

¹⁶ And the gift is not like that which came through the one who sinned. For the judgment which came from one offense resulted in condemnation, but the free gift which came from many offenses resulted in justification. ¹⁷ For if by the one man's offense death reigned through the one, much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.)

¹⁸ Therefore, as through one man's offense judgment came to all men, resulting in condemnation, even so through one Man's righteous act the *free gift* came to all men, resulting in justification of life. ¹⁹ For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so also by one Man's obedience many will be made righteous.

²⁰ Moreover the law entered that the offense might abound. But where **sin abounded**, **grace abounded much more**,

²¹ so that as sin reigned in death, even so grace might reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Romans 6:9-14

⁹knowing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him.

¹⁰ For the death that He died, He died to sin once for all; but the life that He lives, He lives to God.

¹¹ Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

¹² Therefore do not let sin reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts.

¹³ And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but present yourselves to God as being alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness to God.

¹⁴ For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.

Romans 5:21

²¹ so that as sin reigned in death, even so grace might reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Titus 2:11-13

¹¹ For the **grace of God** that brings salvation has **appeared** to all men,

¹² teaching us that, <u>denying ungodliness</u> and <u>worldly</u> <u>lusts</u>, we should live <u>soberly</u>, <u>righteously</u>, and <u>godly</u> <u>in the present age</u>,

¹³ looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ,

¹¹ And they overcame him by the **blood of the Lamb** and by the **word of their testimony**, and they **did not love their lives to the death**.
