1. THE BLESSING UPON MANKIND



Right from the beginning
We were created to be blessed

Genesis 1:27-28

²⁷ So God **created** man in His own image; in the image of God He **created** him; male and female He **created** them.

²⁸ Then God **blessed** them, and God said to them, "Be **fruitful** and **multiply**; **fill** the earth and **subdue** it; have **dominion** over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

2. THE BLESSING OF ABRAHAM



Genesis 12:1-3

¹ Now the LORD had said to Abram:

"Get out of your country,
From your family
And from your father's house,
To a land that I will show you.

² I will make you a great nation; I will **bless** you And make your name great; And you shall be a **blessing**. And I will curse him who curses you;
And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

Genesis 22:17-18

¹⁷ blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply your descendants as the stars of the heaven and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your descendants shall possess the gate of their enemies.

¹⁸ In your seed all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice."

3. THE BLESSING IN CHRIST



Galatians 3:5-9

⁵ Therefore He who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you, *does He do it* by the works of the law, or by the hearing of **faith**?—

- ⁶ just as Abraham "believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness."
 - ⁷ Therefore know that *only* those who are of **faith** are sons of Abraham.

⁸ And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would **justify** the Gentiles by **faith**, preached the **gospel** to **Abraham** beforehand, *saying*, "In you all the nations shall be **blessed**."

⁹ So then those who are of faith are blessed with believing Abraham.

Galatians 3:10-14

10 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse; for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who does not continue in all things which are written in the book of the law, to do them."

¹¹ But that no one is **justified** by the law in the sight of God is evident, for "the **just** shall live by **faith**."

12 Yet the law is not of faith, but "the man who does them shall live by them."

¹³ Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"),

14 that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

John 1:10-14

¹⁰ He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him.

¹¹ He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him.

¹² But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:

¹³ who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

Ephesians 1:3-5

³ Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ,

⁴ just as He **chose us** in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be **holy** and **without blame** before **Him in love**,

⁵ having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, ⁶ to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.





Genesis 14:18-20

¹⁸ Then **Melchizedek** king of Salem brought out bread and wine; he was the **priest of God** Most High.

¹⁹ And he **blessed** him and said:

"Blessed be Abram of God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth;

²⁰ And **blessed** be God Most High, Who has delivered your enemies into your hand."

PRIEST AFTER ORDER OF MELCHIZEDEK

Melchizedek means King of Righteousness

- Melchi = King
- Zedek = Righteousness

JESUS is the KING-PRIEST



Revelation 20:17-18

⁶ Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years.

To be blessed

- Accepted
- The right to become children of God
- Chosen
- **Delivered** from our enemies (sin, self, Satan). The last enemy is death. The second death has no power.
- Redeemed from the curse of the Law
- Kings and Priests unto God, separated unto holiness
