1. HALLOW THE LORD



Isaiah 8:13 KJV

¹³ Sanctify the LORD of hosts himself; and let him be your fear, and let him be your dread.

2. FEAR THE LORD



Genesis 28:10-22

¹⁰ Now Jacob went out from Beersheba and went toward Haran.

¹¹ So he came to a certain place and stayed there all night, because the sun had set. And he took **one** of the **stones** of that place and put it at his head, and he lay down in that place to sleep. ¹² Then he dreamed, and behold, a ladder was set up on the earth, and its top reached to heaven; and there the angels of God were ascending and descending on it.

¹³ And behold, the LORD stood above it and said: "I am the LORD God of Abraham your father and the God of Isaac; the land on which you lie I will give to you and your descendants. ¹⁴ Also your descendants shall be as the dust of the earth; you shall spread abroad to the west and the east, to the north and the south; and in you and in your seed all the families of the earth shall be blessed.

¹⁵ Behold, I am with you and will keep you wherever you go, and will bring you back to this land; for I will not leave you until I have done what I have spoken to you."

²⁰ Then Jacob made a vow, saying, "If God will be with me, and keep me in this way that I am going, and give me bread to eat and clothing to put on,

²¹ so that I come back to my father's house in peace, then the LORD shall be my God.

²² And this stone which I have set as a pillar shall be God's house, and of all that You give me I will surely give a tenth to You."

⁶Therefore it is also contained in the Scripture, "Behold, I lay in **Zion** A **chief cornerstone**, elect, precious, And he who believes on Him will by no means be put to shame."

⁷Therefore, to you who believe, He is precious; but to those who are disobedient,

> "The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone,"

⁸ and "A stone of stumbling And a rock of offense." They stumble, being disobedient to the word, to which they also were appointed.

Romans 9:30-33

³⁰ What shall we say then? That Gentiles, who did not pursue righteousness, have attained to righteousness, even the righteousness of faith;

³¹ but Israel, **pursuing** the **law of righteousness**, has not attained to the **law of righteousness**.

³² Why? Because they did not seek it by faith, but as it were, by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumbling stone.

³³ As it is written:

"Behold, I lay in **Zion** a **stumbling stone** and **rock of offense**, And whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame."
