GREATER GLORY

Isaiah 60:1-3

² For behold, the **darkness** shall cover the earth,
And deep **darkness** the people;
But the **LORD will arise** over you,
And **His glory** will be seen upon you.

¹ **Arise, shine;**

For your **light** has come!

And the **glory of the LORD** is risen upon you.

³ The Gentiles shall come to your light,
And kings to the brightness of your rising.

Romans 8:26-30

²⁶ Likewise the Spirit also helps in **our weaknesses**. For **we** do not know what **we** should pray for as **we** ought, but the Spirit Himself makes **intercession** for **us** with groanings which cannot be uttered.

²⁷ Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He makes **intercession** for **the saints** according to *the will of God*.

28 And we know that all things work together for good to **those** who love God, to **those** who are the **called** according to **His purpose**.

29 For whom He **foreknew**, He also **predestined** to be **conformed to the image of His Son**, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren.

¹² and the **Levites** who were the **singers**, all those of **Asaph** and **Heman** and **Jeduthun**, with **their sons** and **their brethren**, stood at the east end of the altar, clothed in white linen, having cymbals, stringed instruments and harps, and with them **one hundred and twenty priests** sounding with trumpets—

¹³ indeed it came to pass, when the trumpeters and singers were as **one**, to make **one sound** to be heard in **praising** and **thanking** the LORD, and when they **lifted up their voice** with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and **praised** the LORD, saying:

***“For He is good,
For His mercy endures forever,”***

that the house, the house of the LORD, was **filled**
with **a cloud**,

¹⁴ so that the priests could not continue ministering because of the cloud; for the **glory of the LORD** filled the house of God.

**1. WALK IN THE MINISTRY OF THE WORD &
SPIRIT (2 COR 3; 4)**

2 Corinthians 3:6-18

⁶ who also made us sufficient as ministers of the new covenant, not of the **letter** but of the **Spirit**; for the **letter kills**, but the **Spirit gives life**.

⁷ But if the **ministry of death**, written and **engraved on stones**, was **glorious**, so that the children of Israel could not look steadily at the face of Moses because of the **glory** of his countenance, which **glory** was passing away,

⁸ how will the **ministry of the Spirit** not be **more glorious**?

⁹ For if the **ministry of condemnation** had **glory**, the **ministry of righteousness** exceeds **much more in glory**.

¹⁰ For even what was made glorious had no glory in this respect, because of the glory that excels.

¹¹ For if **what is passing away** was glorious, **what remains** is much more **glorious**.

¹² Therefore, since we have such hope, we use great boldness of speech—

¹³ unlike Moses, who put a veil over his face so that the children of Israel could not look steadily at the end of what was passing away.

¹⁴ But their minds were blinded. For until this day the same veil remains unlifted in the reading of the Old Testament, because the veil is taken away in Christ.

¹⁵ But even to this day, when Moses is read, a veil lies on their heart.

¹⁶ Nevertheless when one **turns to the Lord**, the veil is taken away.

¹⁷ Now the **Lord is the Spirit**; and where the **Spirit of the Lord** is, there is liberty.

¹⁸ But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the **glory of the Lord**, are being transformed into the same image from **glory** to **glory**, just as by the **Spirit of the Lord**.

2 Corinthians 4:7

⁷ But we have **this treasure** in earthen vessels, that the **excellence of the power** may be of God and not of us.

Romans 8:13

¹³ For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to **death** the **deeds of the body, you will live.**
