# Luke 19:1-10

- v.1. The Jesus entered and passed through Jericho.
- v.2. Now behold, there was a man named Zacchaeus who was a chief tax collector, and he was rich.
- v.3. And he sought to see who Jesus was, but could not because of the crowd, for he was of short stature.
- v.4. So he <u>ran ahead</u> and <u>climbed</u> up into a sycamore tree to see Him, for He was going to pass that way.





## Luke 19:1-10

- v.5. And when Jesus came to the place, He looked up and saw him, and said to him, "Zacchaeus, make haste and come down, for today I must stay at your house."
- v.6. So he <u>made haste and came down</u>, and <u>received Him joyfully</u>.
- v.7. But when they saw it, they <u>all complained</u>, saying, "He has gone to be a guest with a man who is a sinner."





## Luke 19:1-10

- v.8. Then Zacchaeus <u>stood</u> and <u>said</u> to the Lord, "Look, Lord, I <u>give half of my goods to the poor</u>; and if I have taken anything from anyone by false accusation, <u>I restore fourfold</u>."
- v.9. And Jesus said to him. "<u>Today salvation</u> has come to this house, because he also is a son of Abraham;
- v.10. for the Son of Man <u>has come to seek and to save that which was lost</u>."





#### 1. Pride

 Greatest sin: excessively self-focused and self-elevating (ie. own importance, achievements, status or possessions)





#### James 4:6

But He gives more grace. Therefore He says:

"God resists the proud,

But gives grace to the humble."





#### 1 Peter 5:5-6

v.5. Likewise you younger people, <u>submit</u> yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be <u>submissive</u> to one another, and be clothed with <u>humility</u>, for

"God resists the proud,
But gives grace to the humble."

v.6. Therefore <u>humble</u> yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He <u>may exalt you in due time</u>,





#### **Matthew 18:1-4**

v.1. At that time the disciples came to Jesus, saying, "Who then is greatest in the kingdom of heaven?"

v.2. Then Jesus called a little child to Him, set him in the midst of them,





#### **Matthew 18:1-4**

v.3. and said, "Assuredly, I say to you, unless you are converted and become as little children, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven.

v.4. Therefore whoever <u>humbles</u> himself as this little child <u>is the greatest</u> in <u>the kingdom of heaven</u>.

v.5. Whoever <u>receives</u> one little child like this in <u>My</u> name receives <u>Me</u>.

#### **Revelation 21:8**

v.8. But the <u>cowardly</u>, <u>unbelieving</u>, <u>abominable</u>, <u>murderers</u>, <u>sexually immoral</u>, <u>sorcerers</u>, <u>idolaters</u>, <u>and all liars</u> shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death."

Matthew 16:24-26

v.24. Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, <u>let him deny himself, and take up his cross and follow Me</u>.

v.25. For whoever <u>desires to save his life will lose it</u>, but <u>whoever loses his life</u> for My sake <u>will find it</u>.





Matthew 16:24-26

v.36. For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul?





Mark 8:34-38

v.34. When He had called the people to Himself, with His disciples also, He said to them, "Whoever desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me.

v.35. For whoever <u>desires to save his life will lose it</u>, but whoever <u>loses his life</u> for <u>My sake</u> and <u>the</u> <u>gospel's will save it</u>.





Mark 8:34-38

v.36. For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul?

v.37. Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul?

v.38. For whoever is <u>ashamed</u> of Me and My words in this <u>adulterous and sinful generation</u>, of him <u>the Son of Man</u> also will be ashamed when He comes in the glory of His Father with the holy angels."





1 John 2:15-16

v.15. Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

v.16. For all that <u>is in the world – the lust of the flesh</u>, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life – is not of the Father but is of the world.

v.1. <u>Do not boast</u> about tomorrow, for you do not know what a day may bring forth.





#### Hebrews 3:7-8

v.7. Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says:

"Today, if you will hear His voice,

v.8. Do not <u>harden your hearts</u> as in the rebellion, In the day of trial in the wilderness,





#### 1 John 1:8 - 2:2

v.8. "If we <u>say</u> that <u>we have no sin</u>, we <u>deceive</u> <u>ourselves</u>, and <u>the truth</u> is not in us.

v.9. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

v.10. If we <u>say</u> that <u>we have not sinned</u>, we make <u>Him</u> a liar, and <u>His word</u> is not in us.



#### 1 John 1:8 - 2:2

v.1. My little children, these things I <u>write</u> to you, <u>so that you may not sin</u>. And if anyone sins, we have an <u>Advocate</u> with <u>the Father</u>, <u>Jesus Christ the righteous</u>.

v.2. And <u>He Himself</u> is <u>the propitiation for our sins</u>, and not for ours only but also for the <u>whole world</u>.
