

The Name of God

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LORD – Lord, all caps in the Old Testament is used for the Hebrew name of God “**Yahweh**” or “**Jehovah.**”

Adonai – a Hebrew word for “**master**” or “**lord.**”

The Jews do not say the name “**Yahweh**” because it is too sacred to utter. As a result they substitute it with “**Adonai**” when reading the scriptures or when referring to God.

Kurios – a Greek word for “**master**” or “**lord.**” It is also used in the **Greek Old Testament** to translate the name “**Yahweh.**”

Therefore, both *Adonai* and *Kurios* can be used in two ways:

1. To refer to a “**master.**”
2. To refer to “**Yahweh**”, the sacred name of God.

Name

- Has to do the with the **nature** and the **character** of the **Person**.
- God's name therefore has to do with His nature and character.

The Name of Jesus

- When we call on His name, what does His name mean?
- The first thought, is “**Salvation.**” “**Yeshua**” means salvation. Is there more to it?
- The Greatest Name ever to be revealed in scripture is found in the name of the **LORD Jesus Christ**

Philippians 2:9-10

⁹ Therefore God also has highly **exalted Him** and **given Him the name** which is **above every name**,

¹⁰ that at the **name of Jesus** every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth,

¹¹ and *that* every tongue should confess that **Jesus Christ is Lord**, to the glory of God the Father.

Exodus 3:13-15

¹³ Then Moses said to God, “Indeed, *when* I come to the children of Israel and say to them, ‘The God of your fathers has sent me to you,’ and they say to me, ‘What *is* His name?’ what shall I say to them?”

¹⁴ And God said to Moses, “**I AM WHO I AM.**” And He said, “Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, ‘**I AM** has sent me to you.’ ”

¹⁵ Moreover God said to Moses, “Thus you shall say to the children of Israel: ‘The **LORD** God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you. This *is* My name forever, and this *is* My memorial to all generations.’”

Biblical Hebrew - Tenses

- **Perfect Tense** (completed action) and **Imperfect Tense** (Incomplete action)
- Imperfect Tense can be something that **already is**, yet, **still happening** and **will continue** to happen
- **I AM WHO I AM** could be translated **I WILL BE WHO I WILL BE**
- Who was and is and is to come

John 8:52-58

⁵² Then the Jews said to Him, “Now we know that You have a demon! Abraham is dead, and the prophets; and You say, ‘If anyone keeps My word he shall never taste death.’”

⁵³ Are You greater than our father Abraham, who is dead? And the prophets are dead. Who do You make Yourself out to be?”

⁵⁴ Jesus answered, “If I honor Myself, My honor is nothing. It is My Father who honors Me, of whom you say that He is your God.

Acts 2:36 (LORD)

Greek: kurios – *Master*

– Also used to translate *Yahweh*

Hebrew: *Adonai*

Means “*master*” or “*lord*”

It was used as a substitute for Yahweh because it was too sacred to pronounce

Our English Bible follows the same trend in which Yahweh is translated as LORD

1. The LORD our **Provider**
2. The LORD of **Shepherd**
3. The LORD our **Healer**
4. The LORD our **Peace**
5. The LORD our **Keeper**
6. The LORD our **Righteousness**
7. The LORD of **Host (armies)**
8. The LORD our **Banner**
9. The LORD our **Sanctifier**
10. The LORD our **Salvation**
11. The LORD who **Sees**
12. The LORD of **who is there**
